Why Nonprofits Should Use a Decision Making Framework

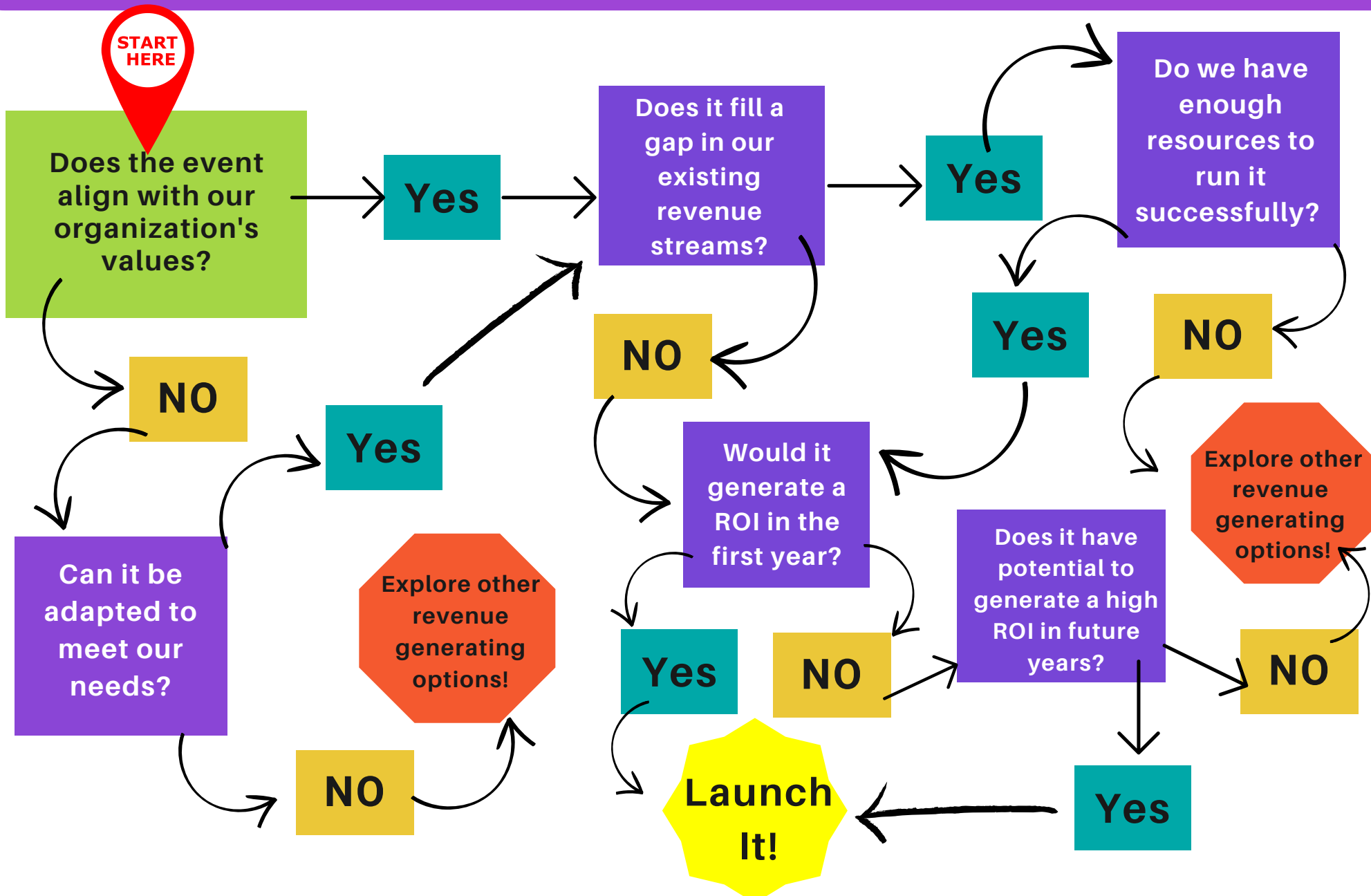

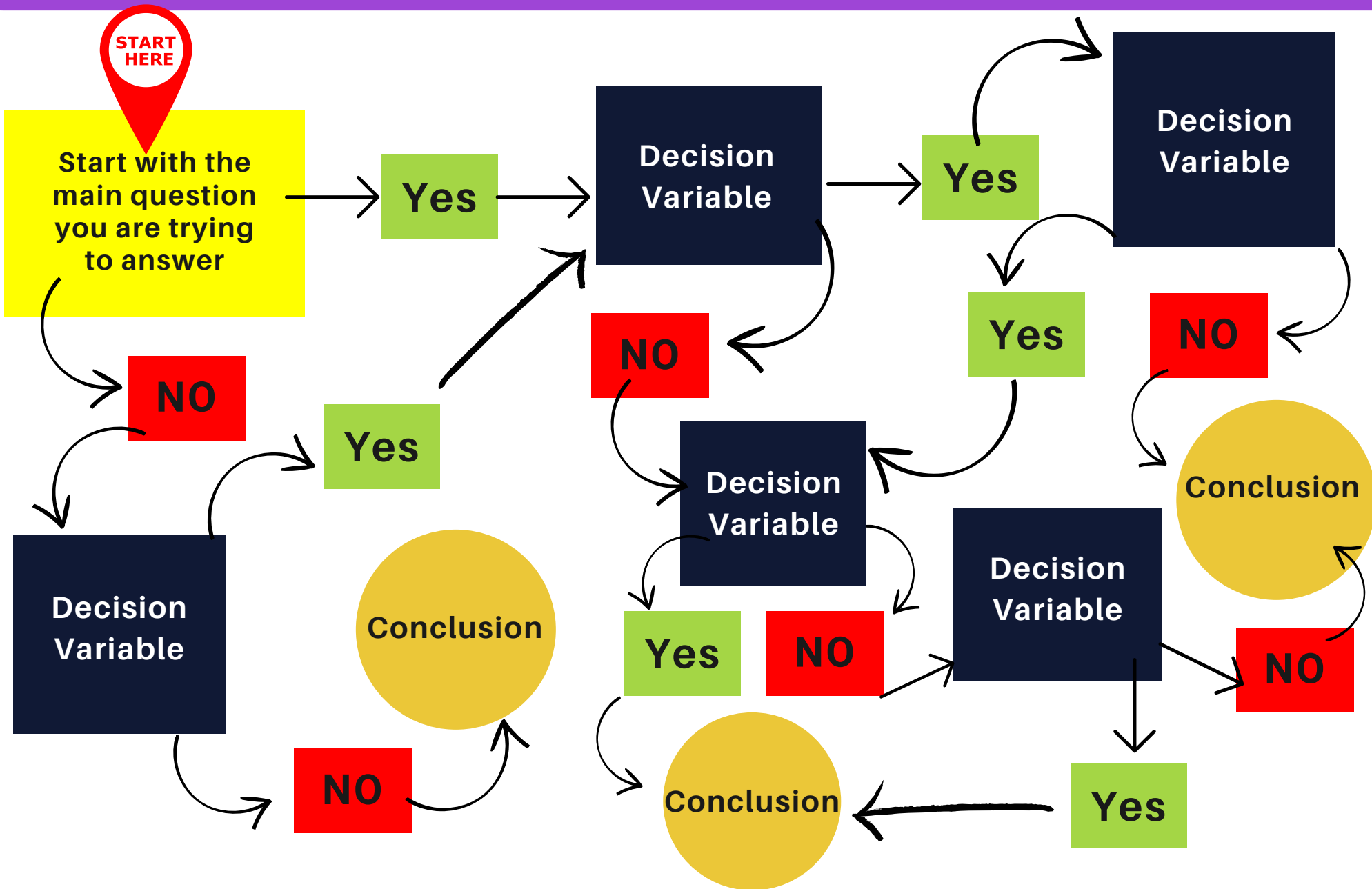
